learned Additional Public Prosecutor.

This is a petition for grant of regular bail
in connection with Magadh University P.S. Case No. 74 of 2017
for offences under Sections 306, 304(B), 201, 120(B)/34 of the
Indian Penal Code.

The accusation in brief is that the petitioner within one
year of marriage killed his wife on account of non-fulfillment of
demand of dowry and only a week before the occurrence he had
gone to the informant demanding rupees one lakh for
purchasing a vehicle. It is alleged that after killing his daughter
the dead body was disposed of without giving any information.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner's wife was suffering from some ailment and as a



result of stomach pain she died. The petitioner has been in custody since 07.02.2017.

Learned counsel for the State submits that there is no medical prescription showing petitioner's wife ailment and every thing is usual in the finding of the Pathological report and in the Ultrasound report annexed by the petitioner and the petitioner's wife was killed within one year of marriage.

Having considered the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is rejected.

The trial court is directed to expedite the trial, preferably conclude the same within one and half years.
