ORAL ORDER

3 18-12-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in Maithani P.S. Case No.
96 of 2018 instituted for the offence under Sections 364(A)/34
of the Indian Penal Code.

In the written report the informant has alleged that
her husband has been kidnapped by 3-4 persons from Bolero
vehicle. Later on she received call on her Mobile number as
mentioned in the written report making demand of ransom of
Rs. 9,00,000/-.

The victim has been recovered and given statement
under Section 164 Cr. P.C. wherein he has stated that kidnappers
were calling name of each other. He heard the name of
petitioner.

The police has not conducted any Test Identification

Petitioner is in custody since 15.7.2018 having clean antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, prayer for bail of the petitioner is allowed. Let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Mr. Juned Alam, learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Begusarai, in connection with Maithani P.S. Case No. 96 of 2018, subject to the condition that both the bailors will be the close relatives of the petitioner.
