Ramnagar P.S.Case No. 480 of 2017 registered for the offences

punishable under Sections 353, 341, 323, 307, 414, 332, 333 of the

Indian Penal Code and 27 of the Arms Act.

Allegation as per FIR is that police raided the place on

apprehended and he named this petitioner.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is that

Having heard both sides and in the facts and circumstances, I am not inclined to grant privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

However, if the petitioner surrenders and make prayer for regular bail, the same shall be considered without being prejudiced by this order, if possible, on the same day.

With the above observation, this application is dismissed.
