2 05-04-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in a case instituted
for the offences under Sections 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation has been made that land in question was
belonging to the complainant and petitioner has wrongly
executed the sale deed. It is basically a civil dispute.

Looking to the facts and circumstances of the case, in
the event of arrest or surrender within four weeks from today,
let petitioners, namely, Baleshwar Singh, be released on
anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten
thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the



satisfaction of the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-V,
Vaishali at Hajipur in connection with Complaint Case
No.2607 of 2013, Tr. No.1315 of 2017, subject to the
conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of
Criminal procedure.
