APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offence punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition
and Excise Act, 2016.

28 litres of country made liquor is said to have been
dumped by the petitioner on the bank of river and managed to
escape seeing the police party.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that no incriminating article has been recovered from the
conscious physical possession of the petitioner. He has no concern
with the seized liquor. He has been falsely implicated in the case



at the instance of enemies. Identity and genuiness of the source of information has not been mentioned in the written report. Petitioner was not apprehended on the spot. Though two more cases under Excise Act have been lodged against the petitioner, but he is on bail in the aforesaid cases. He has been languishing in custody since 09.04.2018.

Considering the facts aforesaid, the above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.D.J.-VI cum Special Judge, Excise, Nalanda in connection with Parwalpur P.S. Case No. 27 of 2018.
