Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

2. This application under Section 482 of Code of
Criminal Procedure has been filed by the petitioner for quashing the
First Information Report (for short 'F.I.R.') of Jehanabad P.S. Case
No. 402 of 2017 registered *inter alia* for the offences under Sections
420 and 409 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. I have perused the F.I.R. as contained in
Annexure-1 to the present application. The allegations made therein
clearly attract the ingredients of a cognizable offence. To hold
investigation into a cognizable offence is statutory duty of the police.
Since a cognizable offence has been reported to the police, I see no



illegality in institution of the F.I.R. or its investigation.

4. In that view of the matter, I see no merit in this application. Accordingly, the application is dismissed.
