Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned

APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in **Mahila (Supaul) P.S. Case**
No.34 of 2018 instituted for the offence under Section(s) 493
Indian Penal Code.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is
cousin brother-in-law of the informant. It is alleged in the written
report that husband of the informant has died. Thereafter, the
petitioner on the pretext of performing marriage established
physical relationship with her but did not perform marriage.
Instant case has been filed only to give pressure to the petitioner
to perform marriage with the informant.

From the written report, it appears that even if



allegation is taken to be true, same was done with consent of the informant. Petitioner is in custody since 08.06.2018.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail is allowed. Let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the **Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Supaul**, in connection with **Mahila (Supaul) P.S. Case No.34 of 2018**, subject to the condition that both the bailors shall be close relative of the petitioner.
