It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that he

has falsely been implicated in this case and has no criminal

antecedent and has been in judicial custody since 04.08.2018.

Having heard both sides, considering the facts and

circumstances of the case, let the petitioner above named, be

released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 25,000 (Rs.



Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Vith Additional Sessions Judge – cum Special Judge, Excise Act, Samastipur, in connection with Samastipur Excise Case No. 231 of 2018, subject to the condition that:-

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.
- (ii) It is made clear that if the petitioner again found involved in any of the like offences, in future, prosecution will be free to move for cancellation of his bail bonds.
