2 05-10-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 457, 380 and 411 of the Indian Penal Code.

The F.I.R. of the occurrence of theft is against unknown. Name of the petitioner surfaced in the confessional statement of co-accused Shrawan Kumar.

Submission is that nothing incriminating was recovered from the house or possession of the petitioner.

Considering the aforesaid fact, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of



Rs.20,000/- (rupees twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending in connection with N.T.P.C. Police Station Case No. 18 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as condition that the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation and trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
