2 05-10-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and
learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in
a case registered for the offences punishable under Section
366 of the Indian Penal Code.

The statement of the victim girl recorded under
Section 164 Cr.P.C. would reveal that she had voluntarily
married with one Om Prakash in a temple and this false
case of abduction/kidnapping had been lodged by the
parents.

Considering the statement of the victim girl, let
the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest
or surrender before the court below within a period of



thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000 (Twenty Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below where the case is pending in connection with Kotwa P.S.Case No. 95 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure and further the petitioners shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioners.
