2 13-12-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as
learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with
Town Police Station Hajipur Case No. 909/2014 registered for
the offences punishable under Sections 419, 420, 465, 466 and
468 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 3 and 10 of the Bihar
Conduct of Examination Act.

The F.I.R. named accused Rakesh Ajit Kumar Singh
@ Rakesh Kumar appeared in place of petitioner in an
examination. Admittedly, the petitioner does not have any
criminal antecedents nor he was caught at the spot.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as
well as submissions of the parties, this anticipatory bail petition
is allowed and it is ordered that petitioner, in the event of his



arrest/ surrender within four weeks from the date of receipt of this order to the court concerned, shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Vaishali at Hajipur in Town Police Station Hajipur Case No. 909/2014, subject to conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
