2 17-12-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection
with Sonapur P.S. Case No. 802 of 2018 for the offence under
Sections 457, 380 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 26, 35
of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners
submits that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent. The name
of the petitioner surfaced on the confessional statement of the
co-accused. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has not committed any offence and no one has seen
the commission of the offence. Except confessional statement
there is no material which shows involvement of the petitioner
in alleged offence.



Considering the totality of the facts situation, let the petitioner above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within one month from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Court of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-1st, Saran at Chapra, in connection with Sonapur P.S. Case No. 802 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 Cr.P.C.
