2 05-12-2018 The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Kudhni
P.S.Case No. 395 of 2018 registered under Sections 379, 401
and 411 of the Indian penal Code.

Allegation, as per the FIR, is of theft of Bolero vehicle of
the informant, which on the basis of GPS has been located at
Bhagwanpur More and intercepted and the petitioner along with
other accused persons were also arrested. The petitioner is
accused in other three cases also.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is that
petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and he is in
custody since 10.08.2018.

Heard learned APP also, who has opposed the prayer for
bail stating that the vehicle was recovered from the possession
of the petitioner and he has many criminal antecedent.



Having heard both sides and in the facts and circumstances, I am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner at this stage.

However, once charge has been framed, the trial court shall release the petitioner on bail to its own satisfaction on condition that he will co-operate in disposal of the trial and shall make himself available as and when required by the court and in the event of failure to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reasons, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail bond.

Accordingly, this application stands disposed of.
