2 11-09-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned APP for
the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case
registered under Sections 344, 323, 313, 315, 493, 498/34 of the
Indian Penal Code.

The prosecution case, in brief, is that the petitioners assaulted
the informant on her abdomen, which caused miscarriage.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioners that the
petitioners have got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation
of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioners. The
petitioners are ladies. The present case has been instituted due to
village politics. No specific overt act has been attributed against



the petitioners. General and omnibus allegation has been made against the petitioners. There is no other substantial evidence to suggest the implication of the petitioners in the present case.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioners are named in the Complaint Case/F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of arrest/surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-Vth, Motihari, East Champaran in connection with Pakridayal P.S. Case No. 69 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
