Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is that

three witnesses have been examined and they have disclosed the

name of the petitioner and two more witnesses are yet to be

examined.

Heard learned APP also.

Having heard both sides and in the facts and

circumstances, I am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

However, learned trial court is directed to expedite the

trial and try to conclude it as soon as possible without giving



unnecessary adjournment to the parties.

With the above observation, this application is dismissed.
