Petitioner seeks bail in **Gaighat P.S. Case No.214 of 2018** instituted for the offence under Section(s) 399, 402, 414 Indian Penal Code and Section 25(1-b)a, 26, 35 of the Arms Act.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has no criminal antecedents. From the seizure list, which is available with First Information Report, it appears that one live cartridge has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner.

Petitioner is in custody since 01.07.2018.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail is allowed. Let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of



Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the **Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-cum-Sub Judge, 16th, Muzaffarpur**, in connection with **Gaighat P.S. Case No.214 of 2018**, subject to the condition that both the bailors shall be close relative of the petitioner.
