2 05-04-2018 Heard the parties.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Sultanganj P.S.Case no.216 of 2016 (G.R.No.3904/16) dated 13.11.2016 , registered for offences punishable under Sections 366A and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioners as per FIR is of kidnapping of the minor girl of the informant by son of the petitioners.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioners is that that they are parents and they have nothing to do with the affairs of their son, who has married with the daughter of the informant, which will appear from Annexure-2 series.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.



Having heard both sides and in view of the fact that the petitioners are not main accused, as such, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from the date of order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.C.J.M. 1st, Bhagalpur in connection with Sultanganj P.S. Case No.216 of 2016 (G.R.No.3904 of 2016), subject to condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

With following conditions :

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioners shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned court.
- (ii) The petitioners will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioners shall co-operate in the investigation of the case and make themselves available as and when required by the Police, otherwise, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of their bail bond.

With the aforesaid observation, this application is allowed.
