2 12-04-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 379/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The FIR of the occurrence of theft is against unknown. The petitioner is in custody since 24.11.2017. Petitioner has stated on oath that nothing has been recovered from his possession. The investigation of the case is already complete against the petitioner and he is ready to cooperate with the trial.

Considering the substance in the aforesaid fact,
let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing
bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two



sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Shahpur Police Station Case No. 40 of 2017, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation and trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
