Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned

APP for the State as well as counsel for the Informant.

Petitioners apprehend their arrest in **Daniawan P.S.**

Case No.40 of 2018 instituted for the offence under Section(s) 147, 148, 149, 324, 307 Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

In the written report, there is specific allegation against co-accused, Mithu Kumar @ Gautam Kumar, of firing from his rifle, which hit in the chest of the Informant causing injury to him.

There is general and omnibus allegation against the



petitioners that they also surrounded the informant armed with fire arms.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of the petitioners for grant of anticipatory bail is allowed. In the event of surrender/arrest of the petitioners, named above, within six weeks from today in connection with **Daniawan P.S. Case No.40 of 2018**, they shall be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the **Judicial Magistrate, 1st class, Patna City, Patna**, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr. P. C. with further conditions: (1) bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned, (2) petitioners shall cooperate in the trial and shall be present on each and every date fixed by the court and their absence on two consecutive dates without proper and reasonable reason will be liable to cancel their bail bonds and (3) if petitioners tamper with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioners.
