2. 04-07-2018 Heard Sri Jitendra Kumar, learned counsel for the
petitioner and learned Addl. Public Prosecutor.

The sole petitioner, apprehending his arrest in Chiraiya P.S. Case No. 131 of 2018, G.R. No. 448 of 2018 registered for offence under Section 30(a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016, has prayed for grant of anticipatory bail.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has drawn my attention to statement made in paragraph – 3 of the petition to show that petitioner is having clean antecedent. He further submits that on false accusation of recovery of about 2 litre of mixed toddy, the petitioner has been made accused.

Considering the nature of accusation and clean antecedent, in the event of his arrest or surrender within a period of six weeks from today, let the petitioner namely Hiralal Rai be



enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of **Rs. 10,000/-** (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Addl. Sessions Judge VII cum Special Judge, Excise, East Champaran at Motihari in connection with Chiraiya P.S. Case No. 131 of 2018, G.R. No. 448 of 2018, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
