APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offence punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition
and Excise Act, 2016.

128.310 litres of foreign liquor is said to have been
recovered from the rear seat and dickey of the Honda City Car and
petitioner who happens to be driver of the said vehicle was
apprehended.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that no incriminating article has been recovered from the
conscious physical possession of the petitioner. He has no concern
with the seized liquor. He happens to be simple driver of the
aforesaid vehicle and was plying the said vehicle as per the



instruction of his owner without knowing keeping of the liquor in the vehicle by its owner. He has been falsely implicated in the case. He has no criminal antecedent. He has been languishing in custody since 19.05.2018.

Considering the facts aforesaid, the above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Addl. District and Sessions Judge-II, Jamui in connection with Case No. 180C2/2018.
