Petitioner retired from the post of peon on
31.10.2017. It has been stated by the petitioner that after his
retirement he was paid only Leave encashment of 300 days and
G.P.F. amount but other retiral dues have not paid on revised
salary of 1st, 2nd, and 3rd A.C.P.// M.A.C.P.

Considering the nature of prayer, this writ application
is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a detailed
representation before the respondent no.6 which will be



disposed of by a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of filing of such representation. Any amount due would be paid to the petitioner within a month thereafter and any inadmissible dues shall be communicated to the petitioner by a speaking order through registered post.
