ORAL ORDER

4 11-09-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and
learned counsel for the State.

The petitioners seek Anticipatory bail in connection
with Roh P.S. Case No. 35 of 2001 registered under Section 7
E.C. Act.

Allegation against petitioners is that petitioner No.
1 lifted 69.76 quintals of rice, petitioner No. 2 lifted 30.88
quintals of rice and petitioner No.3 lifted 24.4 quintals of rice
from Ganesh Godown.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioners that
petitioners are innocent and have been falsely implicated in this



case. Petitioners never deposited bank draft or challan for lifting the rice from the said Godown. Petitioners were also examined under Section 164 of Cr.P.C. in which they stated that they had not lifted any rice from the said Godown. It has been further submitted that other co-accused persons have been graver allegations have been granted anticipatory bail by different Benches of this Court. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of Anticipatory bail is allowed and petitioners named above in the event of arrest or surrender before the court below within four weeks from today, the petitioners are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned S.D.J.M., Nawada, in connection with Roh P.S. Case No. 35 of 2001, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
