Special Case No. 8818 of 2018, arising out of Didarganj P.S.

Case No. 169/2018, registered for offences punishable under

Sections 30(a) and 38(i) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise

Act, 2016.

Allegation is of recovery of 8 litres of Indian made

foreign liquor.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that

he has falsely been implicated in this case and in fact nothing

has been recovered from the petitioner. Further he has no

criminal antecedent and has been in judicial custody since

24.09.2018.

Having heard both sides, in view of the above facts, let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 25,000 (Rs. Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Excise Act, Patna, in connection with Special Case No. 8818 of 2018, arising out of Didarganj P.S. Case No. 169/2018.

It is made clear that if the petitioner again found involved in any of the like offences, in future, prosecution will be free to move for cancellation of his bail bonds
