2 17-12-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Bahera P.S. Case No.82 of 2016 for the offence under Sections 147, 148, 149, 353, 341, 332, 333, 307, 379, 427, 440, 504 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners have no criminal antecedent. In the instant case registered at the instance of Bahera Police Station. Approximately 50-60 persons have been made accused for obstructing the road.

Considering the fact that petitioners have no criminal



antecedent and there is no specific allegation against any of the petitioners and only omnibus allegation was levelled against the members of mob, let, the petitioners above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within one month from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Court of learned A.C.J.M., Benipur, District- Darbhanga in connection with Bahera P.S. Case No. 82 of 2016, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 Cr.P.C.
