2 27-11-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

Petitioner, who is in custody, seeks bail in connection with Budha Colony P.S. Case No. 397 of 2018 registered for the offence punishable under Section 420, 465, 468/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 30(a) of Bihar Prohibition & Excise Act, 2016.

Informant has alleged recovery of 54 litres of foreign liquor from a car which was parked outside the hostel and on seeing police, inmates of the car fled away.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that petitioner is a student and occupant of hostel and was apprehended by the police without any rhyme and reason. He has no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since



09.10.2018.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner named above be released on bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Excise Act, Patna, in connection with Budha Colony P.S. Case No. 397 of 2018 subject to the conditions that:-

(1) Bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned.

(2) Petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the court and his absence on two consecutive dates without proper and sufficient reason the trial court will be at liberty to cancel his bail bond.

(3) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.
