APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 307, 385, 387, 254, 379, 448, 504 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation is that the accused persons including the petitioner assaulted the informant, due to which she sustained injuries.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. The police after investigation had submitted final form in the present case. The petitioner was not sent up for trial.



From perusal of the injury report, which is Annexure-8 to the present application, it is evident that the nature of injury is superficial in nature. No offence under Section 307 of the I.P.C. is made out.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest/surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Munger in connection with Bariyarpur P.S. case No.117 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
