ORAL ORDER

2 05-04-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Sabour (Goradih) P.S. Case No. 291 of 2017 registered for offences under sections 363, 366A/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The statement of the girl has been recorded under Section 164 of the Cr.P.C. wherein she has stated that she had gone to Nagpur on her own volition and remained there with Ashok Paswan for four months. When she could know that a case has been lodged on Ashok Paswan by her parents, she came back and gave her statement.



Looking to the entire facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioners, namely, Ajab Lal Paswan @ Ajab Lal Washna, Manorma Devi, Sony Devi @ Sony Kumari and Ranbir Kumar @ Hital Paswan, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-X, Bhagalpur in connection with Sabour (Goradih) P.S. Case No. 291 of 2017, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
