Delay of 07 days in filing of this appeal stands
condoned. I.A. No. 3167 of 2018 stands allowed and disposed
of.

Taking note of the reasons that weighed with the
learned Writ Court in not interfering into the matter and the
observation made with regard to the manner in which the
petitioner was functioning and discharging her obligations, in
the Anganwadi Centre in question, we are not inclined to
interfere into the matter. The learned Writ Court and the



Collector, having exercised their jurisdiction, and having obtained subjective satisfaction, with regard to the manner in which the petitioner was working, having passed orders on the grounds of violation of principles of natural justice, with regard to the post in question, which is only an honorary post and not a civil post, we are not inclined to interfere into the matter.

The Letters Patent Appeal stands dismissed.
