5 12-09-2018 A supplementary show cause has been filed on behalf of O.P. Nos. 1 to 3, let it be kept on record, since the order of the learned writ Court has been complied with the application is dropped.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at this stage, has shown the photographs of the vehicle and contended that during the period the vehicle has remained in custody all the wheels of the vehicle, tyres and battery have been taken out and if this is the position he is unable to take away the vehicle.



If it is so, he may represent the matter before the concerned authority who had seized the vehicle and, thereupon, the said authority will be liable to answer him. The petitioner will have the liberty to take any other appropriate proceeding.
