However, it is urged that both of them are facing threat. If threat is looming large upon them then the writ petitioner and the girl would be at liberty to approach the Superintendent of Police, Saharsa for police protection in the matter. If such an application is made the same shall be considered in accordance



with law by the Superintendent of Police, Saharsa and appropriate decision should be taken within a reasonable time.
