2 09-10-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP for
the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered
under Sections 147, 148, 149, 448, 354B, 341, 323, 380 & 307 of
the Indian Penal Code and 27 of the Arms Act.

The prosecution case, in brief, is that the accused persons
entered the house of the informant and attempted to outrage her
modesty. It is also alleged that the accused persons made
indiscriminate firing.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the
petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of
tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. There is case
and counter case between the parties. None is said to have been



injured in course of occurrence. The person, passing during the alleged time of occurrence, has filed affidavit stating that he had not sustained any fire arms injury rather he sustained injuries by brick. The other similarly situated co-accused namely, Chiku Kumar has been granted anticipatory bail by a coordinate bench of this Court vide order dated 20-07-2018 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 42335 of 2018.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the Complaint Case/F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest/surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-Ist, Danapur in connection with Bihta P.S. Case No. 517 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
