APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in Rosera P.S. Case No.55
of 2018 registered under Section 30 (a), 30 (b), 38 and 47 of the
Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

31 cartons of foreign liquor is said to have been
recovered from a Bolero vehicle and several accused persons were
apprehended while petitioner and others were identified in course
of escaping from the place of occurrence.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that no incriminating article has been recovered from the
conscious physical possession of the petitioner. He has been
falsely implicated in this case at the instance of his enemy. He has



no concern either with the seized liquor or the vehicle in question.

He was not apprehended on the spot. He has no criminal antecedent and has been languishing in custody since 18.03.2018.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, the above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned 3rd Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge Excise Act, Samastipur in connection with Rosera P.S. Case No.55 of 2018.
