ORAL ORDER

2 25-04-2018 Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

Petitioner apprehends arrest in connection with Dulhin Bazar P.S. Case No. 306 of 2017 registered for the offence punishable under sections 302, 120B of the Indian Penal Code and section 27 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that petitioner has been implicated in the present case due to dirty village politics. Petitioner is the present elected Mukhiya of Gram Panchayat Lala Bhadsara and due to political rivalry his name has been implicated in the present case as per the instance of his rival groups. It is further submitted that nothing specific has been alleged against this petitioner, rather the allegation of firing is against co-accused Dinesh Mahto.



Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, III, Danapur, Patna in connection with Dulhin Bazar P.S. Case No. 306 of 2017 subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
