2 15-05-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned APP for the State.

Petitioner, already in custody, seeks bail in connection
with Basopatti PS Case No.24 of 2018, registered under Section
7 of the E.C. Act.

Allegation in brief is that one bag of rice was
recovered from Md. Firoj Ansari who disclosed that it was
purchased from the PDS shop of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no
shortage of rice was found as it is reflected from the FIR itself
that the remaining rice was found stored in the house of the
petitioner which was also adjacent to the PDS shop and it was
kept there on account of paucity of the space.

Having considered the aforesaid facts and



circumstances, petitioner Subodh Das @ Subadh Saday @ Subhas Das is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned ACJM-V, Madhubani in connection with Basopatti PS Case No.24 of 2018.
