Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and

learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in
a case registered for the offences punishable under Section 30(a)
of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Two persons were going on a motorcycle along
with a bag containing the liquor. When they saw the police they
threw the bag. The seizure-list witnesses disclosed the name of the
petitioners as the person who were seen on the motorcycle. The
petitioners have stated on oath that they have no criminal
antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid material, let the
petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender



before the Court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court-below where the case is pending in connection with Turkauliya (Raghunathpur) Police Station Case No. 444 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as condition that the petitioners shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioners.
