The present writ petition has been filed for a direction to the respondent no. 3 the Sub-Divisional Officer, Aurangabad to revive/renew the P.D.S licence no. 61/85 granted to the petitioner in the year 1985.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it will suffice if the petitioner's representation dated 23.11.2017 (Annexure-4) filed before the Sub-Divisional Officer, Aurangabad (Respondent No. 3) is directed to be disposed of, in which event, the present writ petition need not be pressed on merits.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents appears and has



been heard.

4. Having regard to the nature of the grievances and the stand of the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Sub-Divisional Officer, Aurangabad (Respondent No. 3) to consider and dispose of the petitioner’s representation dated 23.11.2017 (Annexure-4), if the same is pending before him, after grant of opportunity of hearing to the petitioner in accordance with law expeditiously and preferably within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this judgment.
