2 08-10-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Kateya P.S. Case No. 139 of 2018 for the offence registered
under Sections 341, 323, 307, 504, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal
Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there are
series of litigations with case and counter case between the parties.
It is further submitted that both sides sustained injuries. The same
fact has been corroborated in the first information report which is
annexed as Annexure -2 to the present application.

Considering the nature of dispute between the parties
and that there is case and counter case between the parties and also
because the petitioner has no criminal antecedent, let the



petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate XV, Gopalganj in connection with Kateya P.S. Case No. 139 of 2018, subject to the condition as laid under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
