2 06-11-2018 The learned counsel appearing for the respondents

has raised the issue of maintainability of the present writ petition, however the same is not required to be gone into since the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take recourse to appropriate proceedings in view of the arbitration clause as also in view of Section 9 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act (as amended by the 2015 amendment).

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case as also the submissions made by the learned counsel



appearing for the parties, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner as aforesaid, however for a period of four weeks, no coercive steps shall be taken against the petitioner herein in pursuance to the office order dated 03.11.2018 passed by the respondent no. 4.
