3 03-10-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned A.P.P. for the State.

The Petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Rail P.S. Son Nagar Case No. 11 of 2018, registered for offences
punishable under Section 379 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per F.I.R. allegation against the petitioner is that
the petitioner along with other unknown persons is of committing
theft of the motorcycle of the informant.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner
is that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case and
nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner
and he has been named on the confessional statement of co-
accused, Dinesh and he is in custody since 16.05.2018.



Heard learned A.P.P also.

Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioner, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Railway, Gaya in connection with Rail P.S. Sone Nagar Case No. 11 of 2018, subject to the following conditions:-

- i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.
- ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- iii) It is made clear that if petitioner found involved in any of the like offences, in future, prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail bonds.
