ORAL ORDER

3 11-12-2018 The petitioner seeks bail in anticipation of his

arrest in connection with Karpi P.S. Case No. 88 of 2018

dated 23.06.2018 instituted for the offences under Sections

341, 447, 323, 307, 504, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

For preventing the petitioner and others from

urinating near the dilapidated house of the informant, an

occurrence is stated to have taken place in which the

informant has been assaulted by the petitioner and others.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has

submitted that the allegation against the petitioner is general

and omnibus in nature. He has further submitted that the



injuries suffered by the informant are simple in nature and the petitioner does not have any criminal antecedents.

Regard being had to the aforesaid facts, the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today before the learned Court below, is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousands) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Arwal in connection with Karpi P.S. Case No. 88 of 2018, subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
