the petitioner. Let it be kept on the record.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in **Mashrak P.S. Case No. 245
of 2018** instituted for the offence under Section(s) 399, 402
Indian Penal Code and Sections 25(1-b)a, 26, 35 Arms Act.

Petitioner has mentioned in paragraph-3 of the bail
petition that petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Case diary along with antecedent of the petitioner was
called for from the court below which has been received. There
is mention of criminal antecedent of petitioner in the case diary.

Supplementary affidavit has been filed on behalf of
the petitioner stating therein that four other cases are pending



against him. As such, the petitioner has concealed the facts about his criminal antecedent in paragraph-3 of the bail petition.

It is alleged in the written report that one country made pistol and live cartridges have been recovered from possession of the petitioner.

The petitioner has concealed in paragraph-3 that other cases are pending against him. There is recovery of firearm from his possession.

Therefore, prayer for bail of petitioner stands rejected.

The court below is directed to expedite the trial.

Petitioner is given liberty to renew his prayer for bail after six months if no substantive progress is made in the case in court below.
