The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case he is granted a liberty to file representation before the respondent no.3 and the respondent no.3 may be directed to dispose of the representation of the petitioner within a specified time frame.

Accordingly, it is directed that the petitioner shall file a representation before the respondent no.3 regarding his grievances raised in the writ petition within a period of four



weeks from today and the respondent no.3 is directed to dispose of the same within a period of twelve weeks thereafter.
