2. This instant appeal is preferred challenging the order of conviction and sentence passed by the learned Trial Court, wherein, this appellant was sentenced to suffer rigorous imprisonment for 7 (seven) years for commission of offence under Sections 392/397 along with the fine.
3. From the report submitted by the department it appears that another appeal was preferred by one of the convicts namely, Babaji Nayak, against the self-same order being CRA 156 of 2005 and the said appeal was disposed of by this Court on 7.3.2006.
