Accordingly, the application being CAN/1/2018 (Old No.:CAN/2193/2018) is not at all tenable under the eye of law.

Anyway, despite the order passed by this Court the matter is listed for hearing. So, there is no need to pass any order in connection with this revisional application.

Department should be more cautious in future in listing the matter when it is apparent from the order sheet that the case has already been disposed of on merit.
