04/ 17.08.2018 When the case was called out no one has appeared on behalf of either of the parties however, this case is being disposed of on the basis of averments made in the writ petition.

2. Petitioner has approached this Court with a prayer for a direction upon the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner for his request for Inter Divisional Transfer in Railways from Bilaspur Division to Dhanbad Division on the ground that his mother is suffering from serious ailment.
3. The case of the petitioner lies in a narrow compass. The petitioner was appointed under the respondent on 17.11.2014. It is the case of the petitioner that his mother is suffering from severe disease and resides at her native place in Dhanbad District and no one is there to look after her as the father of the petitioners is also an old person and as such, a request was made by the petitioner to transfer him from Bilaspur to Dhanbad but till date no action has been taken by the respondents on his request.
4. From perusal of the records and in view of the averments made in the writ petition, this Court is of the considered opinion that suffice it would be if the

petitioner files a fresh representation before the respondent-authorities within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and upon receipt of the same, the respondents shall consider the case of the petitioner, in accordance with law and passed a reasoned order, within a further period of four weeks. Needless to say that any decision in this regard shall be communicated to the petitioner forthwith.

5. Resultantly, the writ petition stands disposed.
