- (2) Prayer appears to be fair and reasonable and accordingly the same is allowed.
- (3) Be that as it may, if the petitioner files reply to the notice issued by Municipal Corporation within a period of three weeks from today, the same shall be considered and decided within a further period of six weeks from the receipt thereof by the respondent No. 2 – Municipal Corporation in accordance with law.
- (4) Interim order granted earlier shall remain in force for a period of 10 weeks.
- (5) With the aforesaid observation, the writ petition stands finally disposed of.
