(1) Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners would submit that petitioners' land has been acquired but rehabilitation / employment has not been granted to them, for which, they made representation to the respondents authorities but the same has not been considered

and decided till date and, therefore, the same may be directed to be decided expeditiously.

(2) Be that as it may, the respondents authorities are directed to consider and dispose of the petitioners' representation for rehabilitation / employment in lieu of acquisition of their land strictly in accordance with law expeditiously. This Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the matter and the authority concerned is free to decide the petitioners' representation on its own merit strictly in accordance with law.

(3) With the aforesaid observation, the writ petition stands finally disposed of.
