1. Petitioner has preferred this petition seeking a direction to the respondent authorities to register the FIR against respondents No.7, 8 & 9 for commission of a cognizable offence as it is stated that by forged and false personification a sale deed has been registered without the knowledge of the petitioner.
2. In view of the law laid down by the Supreme Court in **Ram Lal Narang v. State (Delhi Admn.) (AIR 1979 SC 1791)** and **Lalita Kumari v. Government of Uttar Pradesh and Others {(2014) 2 SCC 1}** wherein it has been held that in such complaints/FIR disclosing commission of cognizable offence, the concerned police shall register the FIR, complete the investigation within a reasonable time, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the concerned police to proceed in accordance with law and do the needful for completing the investigation at the earliest.
