(2) Be that as it may, the petitioner is at liberty to approach to the District Judge for redressal of his grievance in accordance with para-26 of the decision rendered by the Supreme Court in the matter

of **Power Grid Corporation of India Limited Vs. Century Textiles and Industries Limited & Others** reported in **(2017) 5 SCC 143** within a period of 15 days from today.

(3) With the aforesaid observation, the writ petition stands finally disposed of. No order as to costs.
